The Coal Miner's Honor Garden is the project of the Black Diamond Historical Society/Museum. The Honor Garden strives to remember those coal miners who lost their lives underground in Washington State coal mines and to honor coal miners, their families, and other pioneers who worked so hard to establish mining communities and towns.

The Coal Miner's Honor Garden features a life-size bronze coal miner statue and granite memorial wall inscribed with the names of the 1,100 coal miners who lost their lives in the State of Washington State. A granite pedestal supports the Bronze Statue. Granite memorial benches and donation pavers with personal inscriptions of donors surround the site.
